TYPES OF FAMILY

1. NUCLEAR FAMILY

2. JOINT FAMILY

1. **Nuclear Family** – A family is called a nuclear family. Where parents and their children live.
2. **Joint Family** – Where grand Parents, parents, aunt, uncle, and cousins live together, such a large family called a joint family.

Grand Parents - Grandfather and Grandmother together call grandparents.

Surname – The members of a family share a common last name. This is called their surname.

- ❖ Provide nutritious food for growth

- ❖ Be kind to them
