- 2. <u>Joint Family</u> Where grand Parents, parents, aunt, uncle, and cousins live together, such a large family called a joint family.

Grand Parents - Grandfather and Grandmother together call grandparents.

Surname – The members of a family share a common last name. This is called their surname.
