CHAPTER 2. SUBJECT AND PREDICATE

A sentence can be divided into two parts, the subject and the predicate.

- The part of a sentence that speaks about somebody or something is called the subject.

The subject names the person, place, animal or thing we are talking about in a sentence.

- The predicate refers to the part which tells us something about the subject.
- The predicate contain the verb.

For example: **The house** is red.

The black car is fast.

The cat drank the milk.

In these sentences, the bold words are subjects and the underlined parts are predicates.
